The Assessor, represented by Deputy Assessor Brian Herring and Doug Webb, did not provide a response due to the petitioner not providing evidence.

The burden of proof is on the petitioner to provide clear, cogent, and convincing evidence to support the appeal. Other than photos and statements regarding drainage problems, the petitioner did not provide evidence to support a value change, such as cost to cure bids from a licensed contractor for correction of the stated drainage issues. Therefore, the Board finds that the petitioner has failed to overcome the evidentiary standard necessary to overrule the assessor.
