b) EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES:

5. Personal Services Agreement with Mike Lanker, D.O., to provide assistance to the primary, appointed Skagit County EMS Physician Medical Program Director (MPD) pursuant to RCW 18.71.212. Compensation is based on rate schedule and shall not exceed \$3,342.35 per month. The Agreement is ratified to commence on January 1, 2026, and continue until December 31, 2026.

c) FACILITIES MANAGEMENT:

6. Personal Services Agreement with OAC Services, Inc. to provide pre-bond planning, public outreach, and polling to support capital improvements at the Law and Justice Campus in Mount Vernon. Compensation is based on a fee schedule and shall not exceed \$190,000 plus applicable taxes. The Agreement shall commence on the date execution and continue until December 31, 2027.

d) PARKS, RECREATION, AND FAIR:

7. Personal Services Agreement with Northwest Surveying and GPS to provide surveying, mapping, and related services for the Big Rock Park project located on Big Lake Road in Mount Vernon, Parcel No. P27660. Compensation shall not exceed \$6,000. The Agreement shall commence on the date of execution and continue until December 31, 2026.

e) PROSECUTING ATTORNEY:

8. Resolution to provide legal defense to Skagit County judicial officers Heather D. Shand, Elizabeth Y. Neidzowski, Laura M. Riquelme, Thomas L. Verge, Mary Crandell, Haley Sebens, Rebecca Carroll, and Patrick A. Eason in a lawsuit filed under Case Number 25-cv-02338-LK.

f) PUBLIC HEALTH:

9. Rental Agreement with Swinomish Indian Tribal Community dba Swinomish Casino & Lodge for use of the Event Center, set up, takedown, food and beverage service for a North Star Symposium taking place on May 21, 2026. Compensation shall not exceed \$11,600. The Agreement is ratified to commence on January 15, 2026, and continue until June 30, 2026.
10. Personal Services Agreement with New Earth Recovery to operate three (3) Recovery Residences that will house a monthly average of sixteen (16) people seeking to maintain recovery from substance use disorders. Compensation is based on a rate schedule and shall not exceed \$230,004. The Agreement is ratified to commence on January 1, 2026, and continue until December 31, 2026.
11. Personal Services Agreement with Northwest Regional Council to provide Recovery Care Coordination (RCC) Services to eligible individuals with moderate to severe behavioral health disorders. Compensation is based on a rate schedule and shall not exceed \$185,000. The Agreement is ratified to commence on January 1, 2026, and continue until December 31, 2026.

g) PUBLIC WORKS:

12. Vendor Services Agreement with Carlson Construction, Inc. for the removal of large woody debris from North Fork Bridge on Best Road. Compensation is based on an hourly rate schedule and shall not exceed \$15,000. The Agreement shall commence on the date of execution and shall continue for two (2) years.
13. Interlocal Cooperative Agreement with the City of Burlington to provide reimbursable services on behalf of the City regarding the development and implementation of a stormwater source control program intended to satisfy the requirements of the City's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Western Washington Phase II Municipal Stormwater Permit. Compensation to Skagit County is based on a quarterly rate schedule and shall not exceed \$50,000 annually. The Agreement is ratified to commence on January 1, 2026, and continue until December 31, 2027.

h) TREASURER:

14. Amendment No. 4 to Vendor Services Agreement No. C20160198 with KeyBank National Association to provide banking services and products. This Amendment extends the term of the Agreement to December 31, 2026. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement and prior Amendments shall remain in effect.
