- 5. Amendment No. 2 to Interlocal Cooperative Agreement No. C20220486 with Port of Anacortes to award \$250,000 of Economic Development/Public Facilities Projects grant funds to support Curtis Wharf Access Improvement Project. This Amendment extends the term of the Agreement from August 31, 2023 to May 1, 2024 to complete the project that had been delayed due to the Shoreline Substantial Development review and permit process. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement and prior Amendment shall remain in effect.

6. Interagency Agreement No. IAA24315 with the Washington State Administrative Office of the Courts to administer Truancy, At Risk Youth and Child in Need of Services (Becca) programs pursuant to RCW 13.32A. Compensation to Skagit County shall not exceed \$170,340. The Agreement is ratified to commence on July 1, 2023 and continue until June 30, 2024.

# d) PROSECUTING ATTORNEY:

## e) PUBLIC HEALTH:

- 8. Subaward Agreement with Opportunity Council to provide Tenant Based Rental Assistance (TBRA) in Whatcom County with Federal HOME Funding through the Skagit HOME Consortium. Compensation is based on reimbursement for services and shall not exceed \$125,820.72. The Agreement is ratified to commence on December 1, 2023 and continue until June 30, 2025.
- 9. Data Sharing Agreement for Confidential Information Dataset(s) with the Washington State Department of Health and Skagit County to document the conditions under which the Washington State Department of Health shares confidential information or limited datasets with other entities regarding drug overdose. There is no cost associated with this Agreement. The Agreement shall commence on the date of execution and continue until February 12, 2024.
- 10. Amended and Restated Interlocal Cooperative Agreement with Housing Authority of Skagit County to execute the transfer of Parcel No. P54353, located at 1412 Walter Street in Mount Vernon to Skagit County. This Amended and Restated Interlocal supersedes and replaces the original Agreement, Skagit County Contract No. C20190468. Housing Authority of Skagit County will execute the Quit Claim Deed, transferring the Walter Street Property back to Skagit County and execute any other documents required to complete the transfer. Skagit County shall reimburse the Housing Authority of Skagit County \$10,000 as provided for in the original Agreement, and an additional \$6,000 for additional costs incurred for repairs made to the Walter Street Property. Total compensation to Housing Authority of Skagit County shall not exceed \$16,000. The Agreement shall commence on the date of execution and continue in perpetuity.
- 11. Agreement with Northwest Regional Council (260303-CDSME) to provide up to four (4) 6-week sessions of Chronic Disease Self-Management Education classes to the Skagit County senior community. Compensation is based on a reimbursement basis and shall not exceed \$2,000 per 6-week session for a total compensation amount not to exceed \$8,000. The Agreement is ratified to commence on June 1, 2023 and continue until June 30, 2026.
