Amendment No. 2 to Interagency Agreement No. C20160560 with North Sound Behavioral Health Organization, Contract #NORTH SOUND BHO-SKAGIT-ADMIN-17, for the provision of behavioral health administrative support services by way of providing necessary personnel including appointment of county coordinator, resource management support, as well as various committees. This Amendment adds Attachment V-2 regarding Contract Deliverables. Compensation to Skagit County remains the same and shall not exceed \$611,412. The term remains the same and shall continue until December 31, 2017. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement and subsequent Amendment shall remain in effect.
- 7. County Program Agreement with the Washington State Department of Social and Health Services, Division of Behavioral Health and Recovery, DSHS Agreement Number 1763-94269.
