Skagit County's match requirements will increase from \$0 to an amount not to exceed \$43,083. The project cost estimate was done well before funding was awarded and as a result, once funding became available the project cost estimate was no longer accurate. Once Request for Qualification responses were received and a project engineer was chosen, more funds were necessary to complete the required services. The term of the Agreement

remains the same and shall expire on December 31, 2020. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement shall remain in effect.

- 11. Amendment No. 1 to Washington State Recreation and Conservation Office (RCO) Project Agreement No. 19-1638P, Skagit County Contract No. C20190423, for the Fisher Creek at Starbird Road (2.45) Design. This Amendment increases the total grant award by \$37,685 for a total grant award not to exceed \$177,685. There is no match requirement from Skagit County. The original cost estimate was dated and by the time funding was acquired the estimate was under the cost of the lowest bids. The term of the Agreement remains the same and shall expire on December 31, 2020. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement shall remain in effect.
- 12. Amendment No. 1 to Interagency Agreement No. GVL24546, Skagit County Contract No. C20190479, with the State of Washington Department of Health to expand Skagit County's Pollution Identification and Correction Program in the Samish and Padilla Bay watersheds. This amendment adds \$242,249 in funding to enhance work in the Samish and Padilla Bay watersheds, including added source ID investigation, accelerated property assessments, and identification of septic system failures for a new compensation amount to Skagit County not to exceed \$484,249. This Amendment also extends the term of the Agreement from August 31, 2022, to September 30, 2022. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement shall remain in effect.
