Agreement with PulsePoint Foundation for PulsePoint Respond and supporting infrastructure to support public safety agencies working to improve community cardiac arrest survival rates through improved bystander performance and active citizenship. Compensation shall not exceed \$20,500 which includes a one time set up and implementation fee in the amount of \$10,000 and an annual subscription fee in the amount of \$10,500. The Agreement shall commence on Skagit County's soft launch of PulsePoint Respond and will continue for one year.

d) INFORMATION SERVICES:

5. Vendor Services Agreement with RFI Communications to install proximity card readers at the Parker Building located at 1700 East College Way in Mount Vernon. Compensation shall not exceed \$6,000. The Agreement shall commence on the date of execution and continue for one year.

e) PUBLIC HEALTH:

- 6. Resolution appointing members to the Skagit County Behavioral Health Treatment Sales Tax Allocation Advisory Committee.
- 7. Amendment No. 3 to Contract No. C20220326 with Washington State Health Care Authority, HCA Contract Number K6105, for Recovery Support Services. This Amendment reduces funding from \$518,100 to \$485,833. The term remains the same and shall continue until June 30, 2024. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement and prior Amendments shall remain in effect.
- 8. Amendment No. 1 to Personal Services Agreement No. C20230318 with Skagit Valley Hospitality Association dba Friendship House to provide motel vouchers to shelter a maximum of 12 individuals at any given time to serve households on the Coordinated Entry Housing Interest Pool. This Amendment establishes additional GL Codes for work, adds language regarding Consolidated Homeless Grant guidelines, and increases compensation from \$133,230 to \$338,120. The term remains the same and shall continue until June 30, 2024. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement shall remain in effect.
- 9. Personal Services Agreement with Burlington-Edison School District to fund a school social worker in order to develop and support a Multi-Tiered System of Support (MTSS) practice and teams, increase capacity to implement or maintain programs and practices that prevent or reduce substance use and that target mental health promotion, prevention, and treatment, and to provide workforce development opportunities for district employees addressing behavioral, social and emotional determinants of health and learning. Skagit County shall reimburse the District an amount not to exceed \$90,000. The Agreement is ratified to commence on September 1, 2023 and shall continue until August 31, 2024.

f) PUBLIC WORKS:

- 10. Joint Funding Agreement with the U.S. Geological Survey to operate, help maintain, and publish data from several gauge stations on the Skagit, Sauk, and Samish Rivers. The County's portion of the total fixed cost of \$53,981 shall not exceed \$47,138. The Agreement shall commence on October 1, 2023 and continue until September 30, 2024.
- 11. Amendment No. 1 to Personal Services Agreement No. C20210490 with TranTech Engineering, LLC for the provision of Professional Engineering Services as-needed, on a task order basis on non-federally funded capital road projects. This Amendment replaces the Consultant Rate Sheet, increases compensation by \$40,000, and extends the term of the Agreement by one year to continue until October 18, 2024. Total compensation shall not exceed \$240,000. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement shall remain in effect.

g) SHERIFF:

12. Amendment No. 8 to Personal Services Agreement No. C20170403 with Summit Food Services, LLC aka Food Service Management Company (FSMC) to provide food and commissary services for the Skagit County Community Justice Center. This Amendment extends the term of the Agreement to continue until September 30, 2024 and updates the price per meal charged to the County. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement and prior Amendments shall remain in effect.

3. MISCELLANEOUS AGENDA (items 1 through 2):

a) PUBLIC HEALTH:

- 1. Amendment No. 1 to Personal Services Agreement No. C20230031 with Community Action of Skagit County to provide housing and supportive services to Skagit County Veterans in accordance with all relevant RCWs and the Skagit County Veterans Assistance Funds Policies and Procedures. This Amendment updates the Scope of Work and reduces compensation from \$85,200 to \$45,200. The term remains the same and shall continue until December 31, 2023. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement shall remain in effect
- 2. Subrecipient Agreement with Community Action of Skagit County to administer the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program services for the East County Critical Needs and Homeless Services Project pursuant to CDBG award Contract No. 22-62210-012. The Agreement is ratified to commence on July 1, 2023 and remains in effect for the time during which the Subrecipient remains in control of the CDBG funds. Skagit County shall pass through to Community Action of Skagit County an amount not to exceed \$58,500 in CDBG funds for the eligible incurred costs and expenses for the project.
