

Scoring System-Subject to change. Updated 3/5/20

1st Place-8

2nd place-6

3rd place-4

4th place-3

5th place-2

6th place/participation at all -1

Double Point Competitions -Food Drive, Battle of the bands, lip sync (16 for 1st, 12 for 2nd, 8 for 3rd, etc.)

*in competitions with more 1 person per town (mutton bustin', etc.) towns will be eligible to have multiple people "in the points" (ie. Mount Vernon could get 1st and 3rd place), so essentially these could also be considered double point competitions in a sense.

In competitions with brackets:

In competitions with 6 or 12 contestants in bracket format (cornhole, trivia, tug of war, pedal tractor) first round byes will be done from a random draw (names in the hat)

-6 participants (1 from each town)- First round losers will both receive 5th place, 2nd round losers will both receive 4th place (no consolation rounds). Championship round determines first and 2nd. This is for cornhole, trivia, tug-of-war

-12 Participants (2 from each town)-2nd round losers (4) will all receive 5th place, 3rd round (semi-final) losers will both receive 3rd place. If town does not receive first round bye and both participants lose in the first round, they will receive 1 point (6th place), just for participation. This is for pedal tractor and potato sack races.

Rivalry trophies- While a big trophy will be awarded to the overall winner, there will also be trophies awarded to the winners of these rivalry matchups (Mount Vernon-Burlington, La-Conner-Concrete, Anacortes-Sedro Woolley)
