

4-H CRAFTS EXHIBITS

1. Open to all 4-H members. If you would like to exhibit your project at the State Fair, you must be enrolled in the Creative Arts project.
2. May enter more than one item per division, but no 2 alike. No more than 3 entries per division from the same medium unless otherwise noted.
3. Each entry must include a 3" x 5" card to explain what it is, where it will be used, why and how it was made and what was learned, along with name, age and club. Cards **MUST** be filled out by 4-H members. Cloverbud members are not required to fill out cards.
4. All fabric items must have a 3" x 5" card with care instructions.
5. Machine sewn items must be entered in 4-H Clothing Exhibits.
6. Items intended for display by hanging must have a hanging device securely attached. If the hanging device is inadequate or missing, it will not be displayed.
7. Woodworking items will be entered in STEM exhibits.
