

## 4-H SWINE

Superintendent: Darci Toth, 360-770-7761

1. For additional important information, please read the Guidelines for Animal Exhibitors.
2. Swine (breeding and market) must be under the 4-H member's regular care and management for 60 days prior to the official county exhibit activity.
3. When space is limited, only 2 pigs will be allowed per exhibitor. Skagit County 4-H members have first priority.
4. All swine must be under one year of age, except when a 4-H member has only one animal. No nursing sow is allowed in Showmanship, only in the Sow and Litter division.
5. Use the pig's birth date to determine which class they belong in. Once the judge walks into the arena, there will be no age changes, except at the Judge's discretion.
6. Due to space, size of animal, and pen size, clubs and chapters may not have adjoining pens.
7. Exhibitors must check with the Superintendent prior to entering Sow and Litter. There is only room for two.
8. Sow and Litter will be judged as a separate division; rosettes awarded only.
9. No swine under 45 pounds will be shown except in Sow and Litter.
10. No Crossbred boars allowed.
11. Judge has the right to combine classes but each animal will be judged by their own breed standards.
12. All pens will be cleaned daily before 9:30 am.
13. Only swine-grain ration will be allowed in the barn.

2. No copyrighted illustrations or cartoons may be used unless permission has been granted. The display must credit any source of copyrighted information used by permission.
3. All work must have been created during the current 4-H year.
4. All educational displays must be labeled on the back with the following information:  
Name, First and Last  
County  
Club  
Age Division (Cloverbud, Junior, Intermediate, Senior)  
Department (example – Swine)  
(If display is 3D, attach a card with identifying information.)
5. Exhibits will be displayed according to the identified 4-H project area in the appropriate barn/building, as space permits.
6. **Educational displays will be accepted on Wednesday during haul in.**
7. For displays identified with an animal project area, check individual animal project divisions for specific criteria, if any.
8. Entries must be the work of the individual exhibitor.
9. Poster surfaces should be flat; no dimensional attachments, no foam core board. The Poster's minimum size is 14" x 22"; maximum size is 22" x 28".
10. Charts and graphs are not dimensional.
