1. Entries are due online at www.skagitcounty.net/fair by the 2nd Friday of July. **NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED!**
2. For the purpose of this exhibition, the terms "Cock" and "Hen" shall mean birds hatched prior to the current year. "Cockerel" and "Pullet" shall mean birds hatched in the current year. If your bird is still making peeping sounds or is not at least 4 months old it will not be accepted into the show with the exception of market birds for the stock sale.
3. All exhibitors are required to complete 4 hours of herdsmanship over the course of the Fair. Exhibitors will be assigned herdsmanship duties by the Superintendent. Exhibitors must be checked in and out of their herdsmanship duties by a Superintendent. Our fair day times: 9 am – 9 pm. Failure to complete these duties will result in non payment of premium.
4. Decision of judges shall be final.
5. Poultry shown in FFA may not be entered in Open Division and poultry shown in Open Division may not be shown in FFA.
6. In the Exhibition Division, we will not accept **cross breeds** or **any birds that are not admitted to the American Standard of Perfection or the American Bantam Standard published by the American Poultry Association** in the exhibition department of the show. Cross breeds will be turned away at check in. The only exception to this rule is for birds entered in the Egg Production Division and the Market Class Division listed below.
7. **Fitting and showing is a requirement in order to receive your premium money. Failure to participate will result in no payment.**

EGG PRODUCTION DIVISION

This class has been created for those of you who do not wish to enter your birds in the exhibition division and/or those of you who have cross breeds and would still like to participate in coming to fair.

Requirements:

1. Egg production birds must be entered as such. (Your options being Production laying hen or Production laying pullet, bantam or large fowl).
2. Egg production birds must be female, as the males do not lay eggs.
3. Cross breeds are welcome in this category.
4. All production hens and pullets must be entered into the show with **one dozen eggs that have been laid by that specific bird**. These eggs **do not** get entered into Division M: Eggs. (Failure to bring the eggs or the proper eggs laid by the specific animal will result in the animal not being admitted into the show).
5. When you enter this category simply tell us Production bantam or large fowl as well as production hen or pullet.

MARKET DIVISION

This is the class for those who plan to have birds go to auction at the end of the fair. This division includes Market Waterfowl, Market Turkey and Market Chickens. The goal of this Market Chicken category is to show a trio (3 birds) of the same breed, sex, size, weight, and overall condition.

Market Waterfowl animals will NOT be included in the stock sale at the end of fair.

Requirements for Waterfowl:

DUCKS:

1. Please enter under Market Duck Pen of Three.
2. Ducks must be 8 weeks old minimum -10 weeks old maximum.
3. Ducks must weigh at least 6 lbs by fair check in.

GEESE:

1. Please enter under Market Goose Pen of Three or Market Goose Single.
2. All geese must be 4 months old minimum and 6 months old maximum.
3. All geese must weigh at least 10 lbs at fair check in.

Requirements for Chickens:

1. Please enter chickens as a Market Chicken Pen of Three.
2. All Market trios must include 3 market birds.
3. As a fair requirement, all market trios must go to auction at the end of the fair. There are no exceptions to this rule.
4. Cornish Crosses are accepted in this division.
5. Chickens must be under 10 weeks of age and must be a minimum of 5.5 pounds by the time of sale.
6. These birds may not be shown in individual classes in the Exhibition Division.

Requirements for Turkey:

1. Turkeys must be between 12-45 pounds.
2. Hens or Toms are allowed.
3. No crossbreeds will be accepted.
4. These birds may not be shown in individual classes in the Exhibition Division.
