VEGETABLES

Preparation:

Cabbage: Leave 1 set of leaves to be removed upon display.

Corn: Cut stem flush to ear. Leave silk attached. Judge will expose some kernels to determine quality and uniformity.

Cucumbers: Leave 1/2" stem, cut with knife.

Garlic: Cut roots to $\frac{1}{2}$ " and tops to 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

Green Onions: Leave tops.

Onions: Remove as few outer husks as necessary to make the onion look clean and attractive, cut roots to $\frac{1}{2}$ " and tops to 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Potatoes: Wash but do not scrub.

Rhubarb: Leave white root end, remove leaf, but show leaf fan (about 1" long) top end.

Root Vegetables: Snip tops to 1" length. Leave the root attached. Wash but do not scrub.

Squash: Leave about 1" of stem. Wash.

Tomatoes: Pick with scissors. Leave stem $\frac{1}{2}$ " if possible.

REMEMBER: When entering vegetables, cleanliness, uniformity of size and color are the first criteria in judging.
