- 2. The Fine Art department encourages artists of all ages and abilities to display their work at the fair.
- 3. Frames are required for entries in Division C-G. Frames <u>or</u> mattes are <u>required</u> for Divisions A, B and F. Mattes include art mattes, foam core board cut to size or very strong, unbendable cardboard. Inexpensive frames are fine. <u>Unframed entries must be matted</u>.
- 4. Sculptures will be displayed on tables, and they must be stable.
- 5. Place your name on the back of each of your entries. Also, to ensure impartiality in judging, please cover your name if it appears on the front of or in a visible place on your entry. Cover will be removed after judging.
- 6. Entries must have been completed within the last 2 years and NOT previously entered in the Skagit County Fair.
- 7. An artist may enter no more than six pieces, but not more than 2 works per class. Entries must be solely the work of the exhibitor.
- 8. Superintendent reserves the right to refuse to display any entries. ALL entries must be family friendly.
- 9. Judging by the Danish System for youth and challenged exhibitors and the American System for adults.
- 10. Please do not remove your art before 8 pm Sunday night of Fair. Please bring your ticket to redeem your artwork.
- 11. All possible precautions are taken to ensure the safety of artwork. Skagit County Fair cannot be held responsible for loss or damage
