### RULES

1. Entries are due online at [www.skagitcounty.net/fair](http://www.skagitcounty.net/fair) by the 2nd Friday of July. NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED!
2. For the purpose of this exhibition, the terms "Cock" and "Hen" shall mean birds hatched prior to the current year. "Cockerel" and "Pullet" shall mean birds hatched in the current year. If your bird is still making peeping sounds, is not completely feathered out, or is not at least 4 months old it will not be accepted into the show.
3. Decision of judges shall be final after the awards are up and signed by the judges.
4. Poultry shown in 4-H may not be entered in Open Division and poultry entered in Open class may not be shown in 4-H.
5. Limit of 5 birds (of each species) per exhibitor.
6. Cross breeds or any birds that are not admitted to the American Standard of Perfection or the American Bantam Standard published by the American Poultry Association will only be accepted into the Rooster Beauty Contest or the Hen Egg Production Class, listed below.
7. There will be a required barn meeting every morning of the fair at 9:30 am.

2. All production hens and pullets must be entered into the show with **one dozen eggs that have been laid by that specific bird**. These eggs **do not** get entered into Division J: Eggs. .
3. When you enter this category simply tell us Production bantam or large fowl as well as production hen or pullet.

## EGG DIVISION

Requirements:

1. Eggs must be from laying flocks of the exhibitor.
2. Eggs will be judged by external quality.
3. Each entry consists of 12 eggs in an egg carton. You may enter up to one dozen in each size and animal species category.
4. Eggs entered in the Egg class may not be the same eggs entered in the Egg Production Class.
