Special events fire permits allow you to burn a small recreational fire in a fully enclosed fire pit or BBQ during a FULL burn ban. You must notify the Skagit County 911 Dispatch Center at 360-424-8192 prior to starting your permitted fire. Permits expire at the end of your event and are only available for a one-day period during a FULL burn ban.

Requirements

- The fire must consist only of charcoal or firewood for the use of cooking.
- The enclosure must be a minimum of 16 inches high and made of cement block, stones or 12-gauge steel.
- A charged garden hose or two five-gallon buckets of water must be on side along with a shovel.
- Burning is not allowed if there is potential for a strong wind, which could scatter sparks and start a fire.
- The party responsible for the burn must be present at all times and remains liable for damages, injuries or other consequences that may result from burning, even with it is carried out in compliance with these regulations.
- Fires must not be left unattended.
- Fires must be completely extinguished with water when the fire is left unattended or when the permit expires.
- The Fire Marshal may rescind the permit if all conditions are not consistently met or during extreme conditions.
