REVISION OF SKAGIT COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH SCHEDULE OF CHARGES

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Skagit County Board of Health will hold a public hearing in the Commissioners Hearing Room, County Administration Building 1800 Continental Place, Mount Vernon, WA on **January 14, 2025 at 9:30 a.m.**, for the purpose of considering public comment and possible action regarding the proposed adoption of revised Skagit County Board of Health Schedule of Charges. The Skagit County Board of Health executed Skagit County Resolution (2024029) finding that that Skagit County Public Health Schedule of Charges needs updating to revise fees for the Environmental Public Health Division so that the fees more closely reflect the actual costs for services such as permitting and inspecting food service establishments, living environment facilities, on-site septic systems and drinking water systems and other fees.

Copies of the proposed Schedule of Charges changes can be obtained by contacting Skagit County Public Health at (360) 416-1500.

This Public Hearing provides an opportunity for the public to give comment to the Skagit County Board of Health. Your views for or against the adoption of the proposed ordinance are invited by attendance, representation, or letter.



The Clerk will need the name and the town or city of residence of those providing public testimony. Once the public hearing is opened, those who have signed up will be called on one- at-a-time to provide public testimony for up to 3 minutes.

Written comments may be submitted by mail or email. Email comments can be sent to EH@co.skagit.wa.us, or can be mailed or delivered to Public Health Administration, 301 Valley Mall Way, #110, Mount Vernon, WA 98273. Both mail and emailed comments must be identified with the subject "Revised Schedule of Charges, Board of Health." All written comments must be received prior to January 14, 2025, to be considered.

Residents who plan to attend a public hearing and have special needs or disabilities are asked to call the Board of County Commissioners Office at (360) 416-1300 at least 96 hours before the hearing to discuss and arrange for any needed accommodation.
