

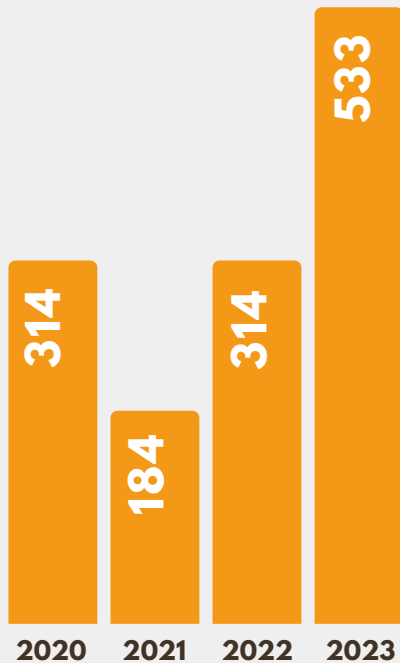
HOMELESSNESS IN SKAGIT COUNTY
