### **2010 program:**

- ***More contact/intensity with fewer students***
  - ❖ 262 sessions/hours with students/parents at schools/community (avg 1 hour each appt)
  - ❖ 107 student/family assessments
  - ❖ 101 service referrals to address issues identified in assessment process
- ***Parent/student resources***
  - ❖ Strengthening families program
  - ❖ FFT counseling
  - ❖ Parent education/support groups
  - ❖ Alternative education/vocational programs
  - ❖ Case management/advocacy
- ***Regular presence at/collaboration with schools***
  - ❖ 7th grade health class presentations
  - ❖ 217 meetings with school staff/providers
  - ❖ Resource fairs, etc

### **Issues**

- ***Students withdrawn before we can get to them***
  - ❖ About 25% - 78 cases
  - ❖ 24 of the 78 met with staff
  - ❖ 24 of the 24 engaged in services/re-enrolled(7)/GED(6)
  - ❖ 4 of 78 confirmed moved out of county/State
- ***Monolingual Spanish speaking families***
  - ❖ About 28% - 96 cases
- ***Prioritizing cases***
  - ❖ 169 truancy cases per staff so far
  - ❖ Balance group/program approach for all with case management for smaller group
- ***Positive number willing/wanting to engage***
  - ❖ About 43%
  - ❖ Case scenarios

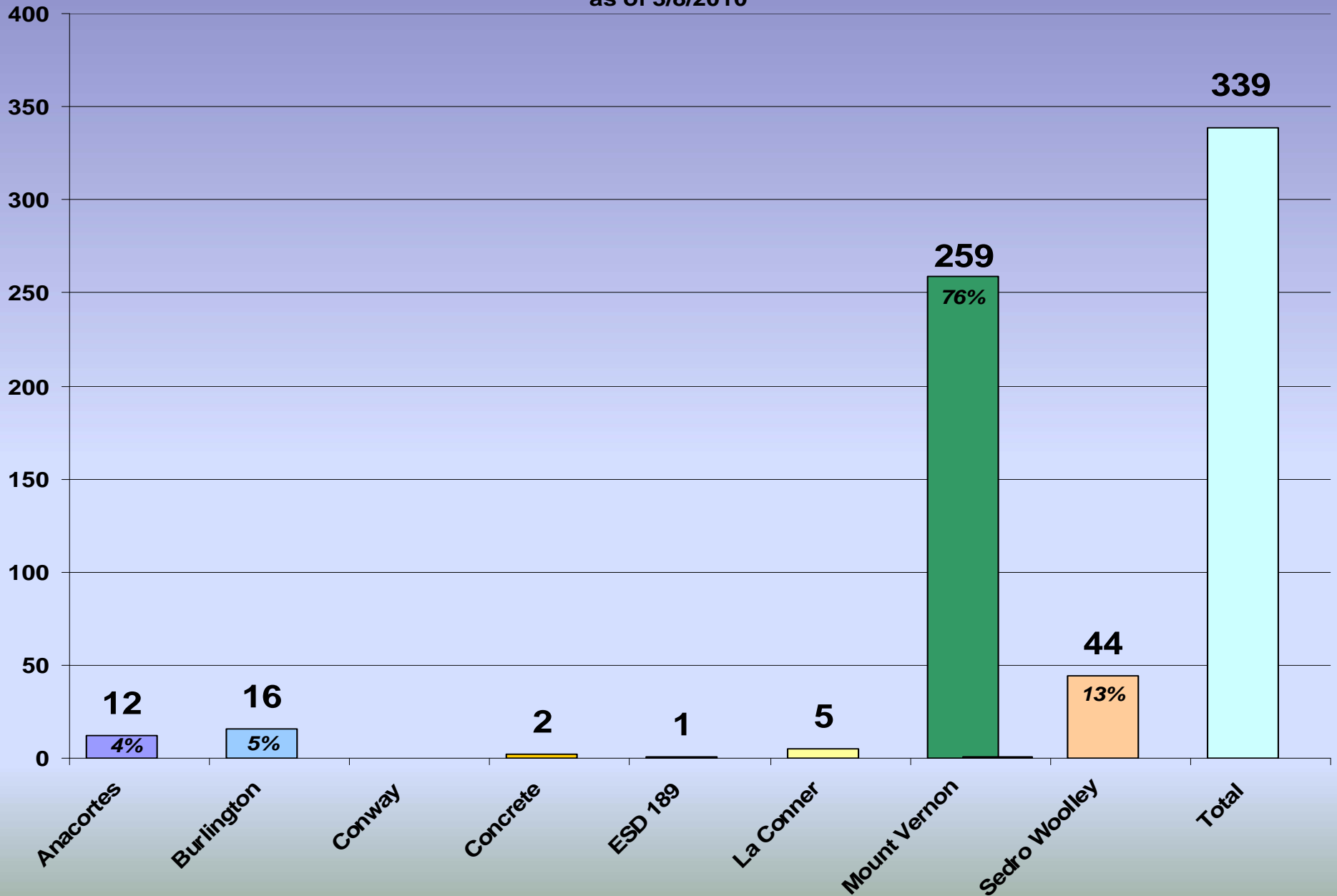
# Skagit County - Annual Truancy Petitions
