Hey Jeff,

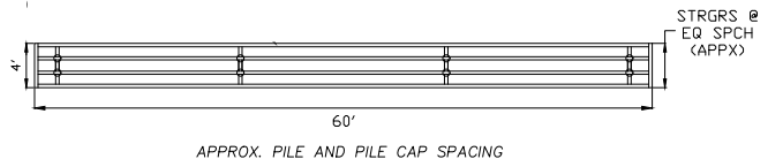

I am now looking at another home on Big Lake, though, and am interested to get another dock quote proactively--smaller dock, new install :)

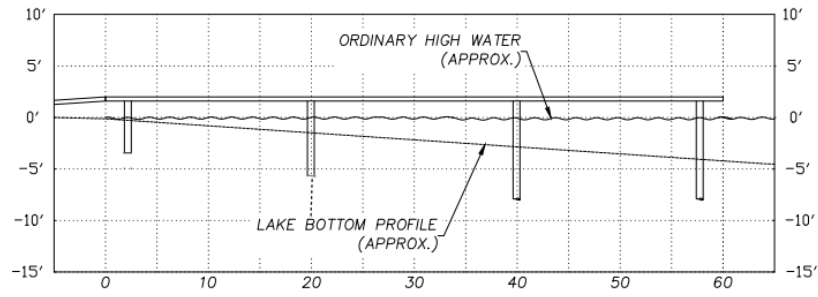
Can you provide a quote to compare against the one we got? I included the sketch we were given if it helps.
