Thank you for your email confirming that we are in compliance with the Administrative Order after submitting the Geologic Hazard Site Assessment on time. We appreciate your guidance.

We are considering withdrawing our appeal now that the deadline has been met. Before doing so, could you please clarify whether any findings of responsibility (related to vegetation removal or the unpermitted staircase) would remain on record if the appeal is withdrawn?

By the way, you are in compliance with your Administrative Order to Abate. You were to have that turned in today. So I don't think an appeal of that Order is needed any longer. You might want to contact our office and see about a refund.
