The events will include musical, movement, visual, healing, literary, performing and culinary arts. The project is located within the Rural Reserve (RRv) zoning/comprehensive plan designation, area at 246 Old Highway 99 N, Bellingham, WA, within a portion of the SW ¼ of the NW ¼ Section 6, Township 36N, Range 04E W.M., and a portion of the SE ¼ of the NE ¼ of Section 1, Township 36N, Range 03E, W.M.
