

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that the Skagit County Hearing Examiner will hold a public hearing on **Wednesday, July 8, 2015** in the Board of County Commissioners Hearing Room, 1800 Continental Place, Mount Vernon, Washington, at **9:00 a.m.** or soon thereafter, for the purpose of determining the following:

- A. **Critical Areas Variance Application #PL14-0460** submitted by Jason & Maria Kitzman. The project included the construction of a 1,000 square foot, two story deck on the north side of the existing residence. The existing residence and associated deck are located approximately 57.6 feet landward of the ordinary high water mark (OHWM) of the Samish River, within the standard critical area buffer. The applicant has submitted a critical areas variance application to reduce the critical areas buffer from 200 feet to 57.6 feet. The proposed project is located within the Rural Reserve (RVR) zoning/comprehensive plan designated area. The proposed project is located at 20654 Prairie Road, Sedro-Woolley within the Northeast quarter of Section 33, Township 36 North, Range 4 East, W.M., unincorporated Skagit County, WA.
