

# Skagit County: Population Summary

Skagit County is located in the Northwest sector of Washington State. About 71,000 people (59%) live in city areas, and 49,000 (41%) live in unincorporated areas. The largest cities are Mount Vernon (33,000), Anacortes (16,000), Sedro-Woolley (11,000) and Burlington (8,000). Four Tribal communities are included in the county boundary: Upper Skagit Tribe, Swinomish Indian Tribal Community, Samish Indian Nation and Sauk-Suiattle Indian Tribe. There are 7 school districts and 3 County Commissioner districts (District 1 [Anacortes, LaConner], District 2 [Mt. Vernon], and District 3 [Burlington, Sedro Woolley and Concrete]). The west side of the county is relatively more populated, and the east side is more rural. Driving distance from the county seat of Mt. Vernon to the easternmost city of Marblemount is about 1 hour, and from Mt. Vernon to the westernmost city of Anacortes is approximately 30 minutes.
