There were no additional matters raised by the public, beyond issues already on the agenda. Minutes for November were approved, as was the January agenda.

#### **Board Discussion**

#### **Pressentin Project and Timeline:**

We will want be creating a low impact loop trail around the site consisting of mowed paths at or near their present locations, and an added section through the forest that generally follows the existing side channel, perhaps with spurs to access the water.

The main trail system we will include 2 pedestrian bridges that would also support park maintenance vehicles (flatbed truck/mower).

We would like to create a handicap accessible loop trail and picnic/possible play area in the floodplain north of the new channel.

At this point the most likely parking area would be near the existing buildings/driveways on the northwest side of the park. We are hoping to pursue acquisition of the adjacent Balise parcels. If acquired future plans may include restrooms/camping.

#### **Grant Projects:**

We have received funds to cover final design work and a significant portion of construction at Pressentin, but we will have to come up with almost \$236,000 in match (\$30,000 for the design Phase).
