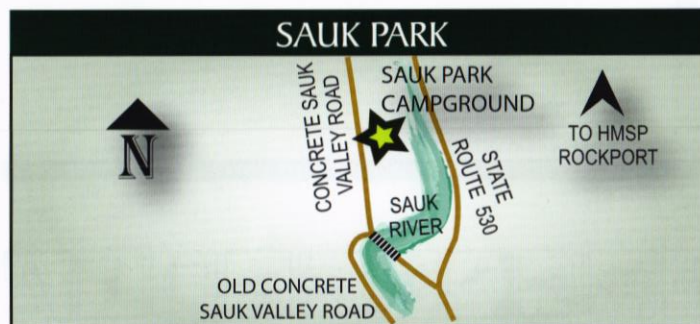

Reservations

Reservations may be made as of January 1st for the same calendar year. A \$10 non-refundable reservation fee is required along with full payment.

RV AND TENT

CHECK IN TIME 2:00 PM, CHECK OUT TIME 1:00 PM

If you arrive early and your site is open you may check in early. If we do not hear from you and your site is unoccupied at 8:00 AM the following day of your reservation, you will be considered a "no-show" and your reservation will be canceled.

CABIN CHECK IN TIME 2:00 PM, CHECK OUT 12:00 PM

CANCELLATION POLICY

Cancellations must be received by phone no less than 14 business days prior to reserved date. Cancellation will result in loss of reservation fee plus \$10.00 cancel fee. 14 business days must be given to avoid loss of 1 night deposit and 7 business days to avoid loss of 2 nights deposit.

We do offer non-reserved sites on a first-come basis. Check with staff or our reservation board for site availability.

Rules

To ensure your stay at HMSP is enjoyable, please honor all park rules and respect the privacy and campsites of others.

Quiet Hours are from 10:00 PM to 8:00 AM

Alcoholic beverages are allowed within the confines of campsites only.

Pets are welcome. Please observe and follow rules. Keep dogs on leash (8 ft), pick up and dispose of waste, and do not allow them into the restrooms.

There is a maximum of 8 people allowed per site, and 4 per cabin.

All sites are limited to one vehicle. Extra vehicles are allowed for an additional fee.

Maximum stay is 14 days.

Please observe and follow the speed limit of **5 mph** within the park to ensure the safety of all park users.

Park in designated areas only and please do not drive on the grass.

Clean campsite prior to departure and deposit litter in designated receptacles **(not in fire pits).**

ATVs, firearms and fireworks are strictly prohibited within the park. Please refer to Park Code 9.41 for more information.
