NOTE →

- NOTE** that select or tryout teams from large or multiple communities may be required to play up a division or grade level at the discretion of the Boys SWISH Basketball League.
- STATE QUALIFIERS** – 4th-8th teams **MUST** opt for upper division to qualify for State Championships (AA/BB/CC/DD)
- “AA” and “A” Divisions (8th Grade), “BB” and “B” Divisions (7th Grade), “CC” Division (6th Grade) and “DD” Division (4th/5th Grades) – Full court pressing and zones allowed. No full court pressing allowed if ahead by 20 or more points.
- “C” Division (6th Grade) & “D1” Division(s) (4th/5th Grades) – Zone defenses allowed, but no full court pressing, except the last two minutes of the game. 3rd Grade teams can ‘opt up’ into D1 Division.
- “D2” Division(s) (3rd/4th Grades ONLY) – No zone defenses allowed. Only man-to-man defensive schemes allowed. No full court pressing, except the last two minutes of the game.
