- 4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> Grade "SILVER" Divisions – Zone defenses allowed, but no full court pressing, except the last 2-minutes of the game.
- 4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> Grade "GOLD" Divisions – Full court pressing and zones allowed. Note that 4<sup>th</sup> Grade GOLD may be combined with 5<sup>th</sup> Grade GOLD for regular season play as a cross-over 4<sup>th</sup>/5<sup>th</sup> Grade Division.
- 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Divisions – Full court pressing and zones allowed.
- **NOTE** that select or tryout teams from large or multiple communities may be required to play up a division or grade level at the discretion of the Girls SWISH Basketball League.
- **STATE QUALIFIERS – 4<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> teams MUST opt for GOLD Division to qualify for State Championships (March 7<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup>)**
- Grade Levels will be combined as needed (i.e. 4<sup>th</sup>/5<sup>th</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>/6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup>).
