On March 18, 2008, at 10:30 a.m. the Skagit County Board of Commissioners will hold a public hearing to consider whether, or which, applications and/or proposals to amend the Skagit County Comprehensive Plan and/or Comprehensive Plan Land Use/Zoning Map should be placed on the docket of annual amendments. If placed on the docket, a proposed amendment will undergo public, agency and environmental review, one or more public hearings before the Planning Commission, and possible final adoption by the Board of Commissioners. If the Board does not place an amendment proposal on the docket for further review, review will stop, and the unused portion of the application fee will be refunded in accordance with the adopted fee schedule. Two citizen-initiated map amendment requests, county-initiated plan amendments, 11 county-initiated map amendment proposals, and 2 subarea plans will be considered for the docket.

The public hearing will be held on Tuesday, March 18, 2008, from 10:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m., in the Board of Commissioners Hearing Room, Skagit County Commissioners Administration Building, 1800 Continental Place, in Mount Vernon.

Changes to the Comprehensive Plan can only occur once in any given year and all amendment proposals must be considered together for the purpose of determining the effects of the action as a whole. Including any proposal on the docket for further review in no way guarantees its ultimate approval. Docketing is merely establishes the list of amendments that will be considered this year. Approval or denial of a docketed proposal will occur after full review and analysis occurs. More public hearings will occur at a later date for those proposals that are docketed for further review.
