Proposal Description

This legislative proposal would amend the Comprehensive Plan's Capital Facilities Plan Element with updated inventory, 20-year needs analysis, and six-year financing plan, and incorporate by reference the updated Transportation Improvement Program to be adopted concurrently. The proposal, and a staff report summarizing the proposal, are available at the website above.

SEPA Threshold Determination

Skagit County has determined that this proposal does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement is not required under the State Environmental Policy Act, RCW 43.21C.030 (2) (c). This determination was made after review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency and available upon request.

This determination is issued pursuant to WAC 197-11-340(2). Skagit County will not act on this proposal for fourteen calendar days from the date of issuance. Written comments regarding this Determination of Non-significance (DNS) must be submitted by the deadline above and in the same

manner as other comments. Pursuant to SCC 14.12.210, no administrative appeal process is available for this legislative action.
