15 proceeding before the Skagit County Hearing Examiner, by and through their respective  
16 undersigned counsel, pursuant to a request of the Hearing Examiner and hereby stipulate  
17 and agree that:

18 1. Condition No. 13(vii) of the MDNS is clarified by this stipulation without  
19 prejudicing any party's position as to the adequacy of the conditions.  
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21 2. Nothing in these stipulations is intended to concern any other MDNS  
22 condition or aspect of the SUP permit application review except as expressly set forth  
23 herein.

24 3. Condition No. 13(vii) states:

25 13. Development shall comply with all requirements from both  
26 Skagit County Planning & Development Services and Skagit  
County Public Works including but not limited to:

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3 vii. The maximum daily truck traffic that is allowed  
4 associated with the subject gravel mine/quarry is limited to an  
5 average of 46 daily trips during mining operations not to exceed  
6 30 trucks per hour under extended hours of operations. To  
7 address the extended conditions, the application will seek  
8 permission from Skagit county prior to generating the higher  
9 truck volume


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11 4. The parties hereby stipulate that MDNS condition No. 13(vii), operates to  
12 impose the following limitations on the amount of truck traffic on Grip Road in Skagit  
13 County during the mining operation authorized by the Special Use Permit:  
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15 (a) The limit in the MDNS is an average of 46 truck trips per day (23  
16 loaded, 23 unloaded), whether single trucks or truck-trailer combinations.

17 (b) During any of the mine operations, at no time will truck traffic  
18 exceed 30 trucks per hour (15 loaded and 15 unloaded).
