On March 29, 2019, the Hearing Examiner issued an Order stating, "that the County issue a formal "written" statement of the "specific requirements" still needed for a complete application."

The Applicant is to have 30 days to respond and therefore the County is to promptly provide a written determination on the subject of completeness. The Examiner then set a tentative date of May 29, 2019 for a Prehearing Conference.

To date, we have heard nothing from the County. When I emailed Ms. Nicoll on April 18th asking for an update on the status of the document complying with the Order I received a response stating that it had been sent and referring me back to the February 22, 2019 letter from the County. I immediately replied on April 18th reminding Ms. Nicoll that the Hearing Examiner (after the February 22, 2019) letter had issued the March 29th Order. Since that time I have received absolutely nothing from the County.

This lack of responsiveness on basic questions is deeply troubling. It is particularly disturbing since the neighbors are objecting to the Applicant's lack of responsiveness. This point was made in our initial appeal and in our subsequent communications to the Hearing Examiner. At this point, we are choosing to limit this communication to your offices without
