Notice is hereby given that on November 27, 2001, Skagit County approved Administrative Decision Request PL01-0673 submitted by Tom Schroers to allow for the road right of way to be included in the front setback requirement for building purposes. The application was determined complete on September 20, 2001.

The proposed project is located at 33470 North Shore Drive, Mt. Vernon (near Lake Cavanaugh); within a portion of Section 22, Township 33 North, Range 6 East W.M., Skagit County, Washington. The parcel is located within a Secondary Forest - Natural Resource Land Zoning/Comprehensive Plan designated area as identified in the Skagit County Comprehensive Plan and associated maps as adopted July 24, 2000.

Pursuant to Skagit County Code 14.06.200, the Notice of Decision shall be forwarded to parties of record, the applicant and other applicable parties of interest.

The applicant and/or a party of record may appeal the decision of the Administrative Official to the Skagit County Hearing Examiner pursuant to the provisions of Section 14.06.110(7). Parties with standing to appeal must submit the appeal form and appeal fees to the Planning and Permit Center within 14 calendar days of the date the decision was issued pursuant to SCC 14.06.110.
