

**SKAGIT COUNTY PLANNING AND PERMIT CENTER
NOTICE OF DEVELOPMENT APPLICATION**

File **BP02-0776**

Notice is hereby given that on July 1, 2002, Sidney DeBoer filed a building permit application (BP02-0776) for the construction/installation of an above ground, glass lined, steel slurrystore tank for the storage of dairy manure. The proposed project includes the construction of a 23 foot high, 162 foot diameter, tank structure with the holding capacity of 3,448,622 U.S. gallons. The proposed project also includes the placement of approximately 1,500 cubic yards of material and the excavation of approximately 1,500 cubic yards of material for the construction of the tank. The proposed project is located within an Agricultural Natural Resource Lands (Ag-NRL) zoning/comprehensive plan designated area as indicated in the Skagit County Comprehensive Plan and associated maps adopted July 24, 2000. A letter of completeness was issued and the application was determined to be complete on July 8, 2002.

The project is located at 8426 District Line Road, Burlington, within a portion of Sections 16, Township 35N, Range 4E W.M., Skagit County, Washington.

A completed Building permit application, Environmental Checklist, Critical Areas checklist and other application materials are on file with the Skagit County Planning and Permit Center. This information is available to the public on request.

There are no other governmental approvals required for this proposal.

A decision on the application will be made within 120 days of the date the application was determined complete, which was 7-8-02. A public hearing before the Skagit County Hearing Examiner is not required for this project.

Any person desiring to express his or her views or be notified of the action taken on this application should notify Brandon Black in writing of his or her interest within Fifteen (15) days of the date of publication of this notice which is 7-11-02.

Written comments must be received by 7-26-02

The Lead Agency expects to issue a DNS for this proposal and the Optional DNS is being used. **This may be the only opportunity to comment on the environmental impacts of the proposal.**
