

DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS)

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: This is a non-project SEPA checklist for an ordinance repealing Section 14.24.130 for the Skagit County Critical Areas Ordinance and amending SCC Section 14.24.120 to reflect the deletion. The section was referred to as the "Strategic Plan to Protect Wild Salmonids".

PROPONENT: Skagit County Planning and Permit Center

PROJECT LOCATION: Skagit County

LEAD AGENCY: Skagit County Planning and Permit Center.

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. Appeals must be submitted within 14 days of the substantive decision.

Appeals must be submitted by 8-30-02.
