Notice is hereby given that on September 27, 2011, the Skagit County Board of County Commissioners signed a resolution upholding the Hearing Examiner approval of Special Use Request (#PL10-0076) submitted by Jeff and Melinda VanDenTop and denying the Appeal Request (PL11-054) submitted by Dr. Kees Hofman. The Special Use Permit will allow for an outdoor shooting club on property designated as Secondary Forest-NRL with the principal purpose of hosting a four day Sporting Clays Tournament to be held annually in August. The closed record appeal hearing was held on September 20, 2011 and the decision was announced on September 27, 2011.

The proposed project is located at 16377 Taylor Road Mount Vernon, WA; ptn of the SW 1/4 of Section 29, Township 34, Range 05 E. W.M. Skagit County, WA; P# NUMBER: P30434, P30437

Pursuant to Skagit County Code 14.06.200, the Notice of Decision shall be forwarded to parties of record, the applicant and other applicable parties of interest.

The applicant and/or a party of record may appeal the decision of the Board of County Commissioners to Superior Court pursuant to the provisions of Section 14.06.220. Parties with standing to appeal must submit the appeal within 21 days from the date of adoption of the resolution or ordinance.
