Proposal Description

State law requires cities and counties to adopt the state building codes as adopted by the State Building Code Council (SBCC). This proposal would amend Skagit County Code Title 15 to update the County's adoption of the International Building Code, International Residential Code, International Mechanical Code, Uniform Plumbing Code, International Fire Code, and International Energy Conservation Code to the 2015 versions adopted by the SBCC, with local exceptions. It would also adopt the 2012 Green Plumbing & Mechanical Code Supplement Appendix B for potable rainwater catchment systems, and portions of the 2015 International Property Maintenance Code for abatement of rundown and dangerous buildings.

The proposal would also update by resolution the Planning & Development Services department fee schedule, to establish fees for Fire Marshal services, move water review fees from Health to Planning, and adjust certain other fees. A staff report is available at the web address above.

SEPA Threshold Determination

Skagit County has determined that this proposal does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement is not required under the State Environmental Policy Act, RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c). This determination was made after review of a

completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency and is available upon request.

This determination is issued pursuant to WAC 197-11-340(2). Skagit County will not act on this proposal during the comment period. Written comments regarding this Determination of Nonsignificance must be submitted by the deadline above and in the same manner as other comments. Pursuant to SCC 14.12.210, no administrative appeal process is available for this legislative action.
