Administrative Special Use Permit File #PL22-0110

Notice is hereby given that on August 3, 2022, Skagit County Planning and Development Services approved the Administrative Special Use Permit (#PL22-0110) submitted by Hollie and Adam Del Vecchio of DV Trees, LLC to allow for temporary events, including but not limited to weddings, at an existing Christmas tree farm located on tax parcels P18000, P18002 and P17972. Attendance will be limited to a maximum of 50 people per event. The proposed project is located within the Rural Reserve (RRv) zoning/comprehensive plan designated areas as indicated in the Skagit County Comprehensive Plan and associated maps. The project is located at 19121 State Route (SR 9), Mount Vernon, within a portion of Section 7, Township 33N, Range 5E W.M., situated within Skagit County, Washington (P18000, P18002, P17972).
