Project Description: On September 30, 2024, Dennis Huston filed a Shoreline Variance/Substantial Development/Conditional Use application to construct a second story addition on the existing non-conforming single-family residence. The subject property is located within the Rural Village Residential zoning/comprehensive plan designated area as indicated in the Skagit County Comprehensive Plan and associated maps adopted March 13, 2023. The application was determined complete for review purposes pursuant to SCC 14.06.100(4).

Project Location: The proposed project is located at 33998 North Shore Drive within a portion of SE ¼ SE ¼ Section 22, Township 33N, Range 06E, W.M., situated within Skagit County, Washington (P66324).
