Notice is hereby given that on October 15, 2024, Gary Lohman of Happy Face Farms, Inc. filed an Administrative Setback Reduction request (#PL24-0388) to accommodate a building envelope for future residential construction. The proposed building envelope is not able to meet the standard 100-foot front and side setback and the side 200-foot side setback from the adjacent Natural Resource Lands. The request is to reduce the required 100-foot setback from the front (west) property line to 20-feet and the required 100-foot side setback as well as the 200-foot setback from the adjacent Natural Resource Lands from the side (north) property line to 10-feet. The subject property is located within the Secondary Forest-Natural Resource Lands (SF-NRL) zoning/comprehensive plan designated area as indicated in the Skagit County Comprehensive Plan and associated maps adopted July 5, 2016. The application was determined complete for review purposes on October 22, 2024.

The project is located at 26551 Lake Cavanaugh Rd, Mount Vernon, within a portion of Section 21, Township 33N, Range 05E W.M., situated within Skagit County, Washington (P137127 & P18180).

A completed Administrative Setback Reduction request, site plan and other application materials are on file with Skagit County Planning and Development Services. This information is available to the public on request. Other governmental approvals or permits that will be needed for this proposal from Planning and Development Services include: Approved Building Permit.

A decision on the application will be made within 120 days of the date the application was determined to be complete, which was October 22, 2024, pursuant to SCC 14.06.210. A public hearing before the Skagit County Hearing Examiner is not required for this project.
