Parties withstanding to appeal must submit the appeal form and appeal fees to the Planning and Development Services Department within 14 calendar days of the date of the Decision, however the appeal period ends on a holiday and therefore will be extended to the next business day.

Affected property owners may request a change in valuation from the county assessor for property tax purposes notwithstanding any program of revaluation.
