

NOTICE OF DECISION

Shoreline Substantial Development & Variance PL22-0445 for Herbert Stickle

On February 20, 2026, the Skagit County Hearing Examiner approved, with conditions, a shoreline substantial development and shoreline variance permit for the construction of hard shoreline stabilization extending south of the existing 121-foot concrete bulkhead approximately 45 linear feet.

On May 13, 2026, the Department of Ecology issued its decision on the shoreline application. Additional conditions are included in the Ecology decision. A copy of that decision can be obtained from the Skagit County Department of Planning and Development Services.

This decision may be appealed to the Shoreline Hearings Board within 21 days of the date of the Ecology decision. Appeals must be filed in accordance with the provisions of WAC 461-08.

The proposed project is located at 15412 Rosario View Lane, Anacortes, Washington, a portion of Section 22, Township 34 North, Range 1 East, W.M., Skagit County, Washington. P19542 & P19541.

The Notice of Decision shall be forwarded to parties of record, the applicant and other applicable parties of interest.
