4. Stormwater Code Update Work Session

Skagit County, along with most other cities and counties in the state, is working to update our stormwater management code (SCC 14.32) and related definitions in response to the new National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Phase II Stormwater Permit for Western Washington. Bill Dowe, Stormwater Permit Program Coordinator for Public Works, will present a description of the NPDES permit requirements and a proposed approach for the code update.
