3. WWU Presentation on Setback Reform

Skagit County has partnered with Western Washington University to review the County's standard zoning setbacks to identify ways the setbacks can be simplified and reduced using best practices. Students from a planning class led by Dr. Tamara Laninga, AICP, have researched Skagit County Code and the code of other jurisdictions, and will make a presentation on their findings.
