# 3. Birdsview Brewery 2014 Comprehensive Plan Amendment Deliberations continued

On September 1, 2015, the Skagit County Planning Commission held a public hearing on the Birdsview Brewery comprehensive plan map amendment proposal. Based on public testimony and other matters of record, the Planning Commission continued the public hearing to September 15, 2015, so that staff could conduct additional analysis and address several relevant issues. The results of that analysis are discussed in this Supplemental Staff Report.

### 4. Conservation and Developments Incentive Program Work Session
