A public hearing was held on September 19, 2017 to consider proposed annual updates to the County's Capital Facilities Plan (CFP) and Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for 2018 to 2023. The Planning Commission will consider the public comments and public hearing testimony and make a recommendation to the Board of County Commissioners on the updates.
