3. Deliberations for 2016-2021 Capital Facilities Plan (CFP) and Transportation Improvement Program and Related Code Amendments

The Planning Commission will deliberate and issue a recommendation to the Board of County Commissioners on adoption of the CFP (including the Transportation Improvement Program) and related code amendments. The Planning Commission held a public hearing on the CFP/TIP on October 6 and the written comment period closed October 8. 4. Conservation and Development Incentives (CDI) Program Work Session - Continued

The Planning Commission will continue its discussion with the Department about the proposal for a new program to enable the voluntary and permanent conservation of farm, forest, and open space lands while encouraging development in urban areas and certain rural areas best suited for additional growth.
