Agricultural Advisory Board (AAB) Chair Michael Hughes opened the meeting with a presentation on AAB priorities and concerns with regards to the agritourism study. Planning Commissioners then took turns asking questions of the AAB members to discuss how potential changes to Skagit County code could affect farmers in the community. The Board of County Commissioners and AAB closed the joint meeting at 8:04pm.
