Summary of Meeting

Approval of Minutes (04/13/2021)

Chair Raschko introduced the meeting minutes from the last meeting (04/13/2021) for approval. A motion to approve the April 13th meeting minutes was initiated by Commissioner Mitchell and was seconded by Commissioner Candler. The minutes were approved unanimously.

Shoreline Master Program (SMP) Work Session (Video at 00:06:30)

The public comment period for the Shoreline Master Program has been extended until June 22nd. Dan Nickel from the Watershed Company gave a presentation on navigating the public review draft and associated maps of the SMP, and an overview of proposed changes following Ecology's preliminary review, including: CAO Integration, Agriculture, Forest Practices, Docks and the Administrative variance process. Mr. Nickel answered several questions regarding the Shoreline Master Plan and related topics.

Chair Raschko led discussion on the proposed definitions for the bylaws from Commissioner Henley. Commissioner Mitchell initiated a motion to approve the Article 1 Definitions as written by Commissioner Henley. Commissioner Mitchell initiated a motion to remove Section 12 of the bylaws. Commissioner Candler seconded the motion. All were in favor after some discussion and the motion was approved unanimously.
