The applicant proposes a seepage berm 33 to 40 feet wide and 4 feet deep to mitigate for flooding from the Skagit River as a result of surface to groundwater movement. This project proposal is being reviewed under the provisions of SCC 14.24 of Skagit County's Unified Development Code and Skagit County's Shoreline Management Master Program.
