Failure to submit comments or request during the comment period could result in loss of right to appeal. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 14.06.200 the Administrative Official will provide a written notice for all final decisions to the applicant and all parties requesting notification of the decision.

Written comments must be received by April 4, 2003.

The applicant and/or a party of record may appeal the decision of the Administrative Official to the Skagit County Hearing Examiner pursuant to the provisions of Section 14.06.160. Every appeal to the Hearing Examiner shall be filed with the Planning & Permit Center within fifteen (15) cale ndar days after the date of the decision of the matter being appealed.
