**Purpose of Hearing:** NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of County Commissioners will hold a Public Hearing in the Commissioners' Hearing Room, County Administration Building, 1800 Continental Place, Mount Vernon, WA, on Tuesday, May 7, 2019, at 9:00a.m., or as soon as possible thereafter, for the purpose of considering the reauthorization of the Skagit County Shellfish Protection District (Clean Water Program) and reestablish budget and finance rates and charges, as recommended by the Skagit County Department of Public Works.

The Skagit County Clean Water Program budget and finance rates and charges (as established pursuant to Resolution # R20150375) are set to expire on December 31, 2019. This proposal is to reauthorize the Shellfish Protection District (Clean Water Program) and reestablish amended budget and finance rates and charges for an additional five years (until December 31, 2024). This proposal may be approved, modified and approved, or rejected by the Board of Skagit County Commissioners. Your views for or against the recommendations of the Department of Public Works are invited by attendance, representation, or letter. A copy of the full text of the proposed resolution will be mailed upon request.
